About mobility in Liepaja

The last mobility in the framework of our international project EASY ERASMUS + was held in Latvia in Liepaja, which lies about 200 km west of the capital of Latvia, Riga. Regarding to the fact that it was actually the last mobility, all students and teachers from partner countries – Bulgaria, Turkey, Portugal, Italy, Czech Republic and Latvia –enjoyed it as much as possible.

The first day of the program took place in the local cinema, it was the opening conference. The first word got the Director of the host school and the presentation followed then, which were prepared by the teams concerning the subject of Entrepreneurial skills and ICT. The task was very interesting and this time each team should prepare a short film, which after all, all participants watched in the cinema. After the screening of the films, invited speakers, the experienced entrepreneurs, took the word. Their lection impressed us very much because they were very young and successful people.

We spent our afternoon in the city and visited all the attractions that were located in the city of Liepaja. In the frame of the program, we visited the Business Incubator – start up, Factory-production engaged

in Lauma lingerie, Bioventa – producing biofuel. Latvian team also prepared for us a tour around the interesting cities such as Liepaji, Kurzeme, Ventspils, Kuldiga and Jurkalne in which we could see the Latvian culture and history. During the week the students were accompanied by many workshops focusing on the main theme concerning Entrepreneurial skills and ICT, for example, a workshop "Digital tools to create and promote your ideas", or Strategic game on entrepreneurship. The last day of the program contained a Farewell dinner this time in the form of a small ball with a final dance party. Everyone enjoyed the night.

n Saturday morning we have received from the Director our certificates, and went to the Riga airport, where we flew home. The city of Liepaja is known as the city where the wind was born – even though, all the participants can actually confirm that the last mobility was marvelous.

It is a business which is based on beauty and understanding of women's desires, it is dynamic, sophisticated and responsible. LAUMA LINGERIE has several advantages, such as many years experience working with both the Eastern and Western markets, as well as a strong management team having both Western and Eastern European experience in the textile production area.

BIOVENTA

The biodiesel fuel manufacturer SIABIOVEN-TA was founded on 5 October 2004, when the sector's jury's professionals AS SILTUM-PROJEKTS started to develop the design of the biodiesel plant. Designing works were completed in 2006 and construction was launched the same year. Presently SIA Bio-Venta is the biggest biodiesel manufacturer in the Baltic countries, with total investments of EUR 77.72 million. The plant consists of rapeseed and rapeseed cake storage and handling facilities, a rapeseed oil press workshop, biodiesel production workshop and biodiesel handling facilities. The biodiesel manufacturing capacity is 100 000 t/per annum, while the rapeseed oil manufacturing capacity is 35 000 t/per annum.

I've found out that living with people at your age could be a lot of fun and it is a great preparation for the future university life


What are your impressions and experiences from the project?

Why have you signed up for the project and what are you waiting from it? Which country did you visit in the framework of the project?


What are your impressions and experiences from the project?


What are your impressions and experiences from the project?
